“A Mocked Messiah”
Matthew 27:27–44

*“Jesus on the cross took our place, so that we can receive His **grace**”*

Sermon Points:

1. Jesus suffered for us (Matt 27:27-30).

A. The 7 things Jesus went through before dying:

- 1) Jesus was stripped naked (v. 28a)
- 2) A scarlet robe was put on Jesus (v. 28b)
- 3) A crown of thorns on Jesus’s head (v. 29a)
- 4) A stick was put in His hand (v. 29b)
- 5) The soldiers knelt before Jesus and mocked Him by saying “Hail, King of the Jews!” (v. 29c)
- 6) The soldiers spat on him (v. 30a)
- 7) The soldiers then took the stick and hit Him on the head (v. 30b)

B. The obedience of Jesus (Isaiah 50:6)

C. Jesus submitted himself to the will of the father (1 Peter 2:23)

2. Jesus *sacrificed* for us.

A. Notice two things about Jesus’s death on the Cross.

- 1) Jesus faced the pain for us (Mt 27:32-38)
- 2) Jesus faced the persecution for us (Mt 27:39-44)
