Sermon Points:

- 1. The Lord’s Prayer is really The Disciple’s Prayer.**
- 2. It was requested as “Teach us to Pray” NOT “Teach us HOW to Pray”.**
- 3. Matthew, Mark and Luke are known as the Synoptic Gospels as they share the same source material.**
 - A. Compare Luke 11:2-4 and Matthew 6:9-1. See the similarities.
- 4. Jesus tells us through the parable (Luke 11:7-8) to Pray with Shameless Audacity and Boldness and Confidence.**
 - A. The Lord waits for our passionate and persistent prayer.
- 5. Jesus teaches us in Luke 11:9-10 to Ask, Seek, and Knock; to Pray with Child-Like Confidence**
 - A. God’s eagerness to give us good things is predicated on being His children.
