### **Faith-filled living**

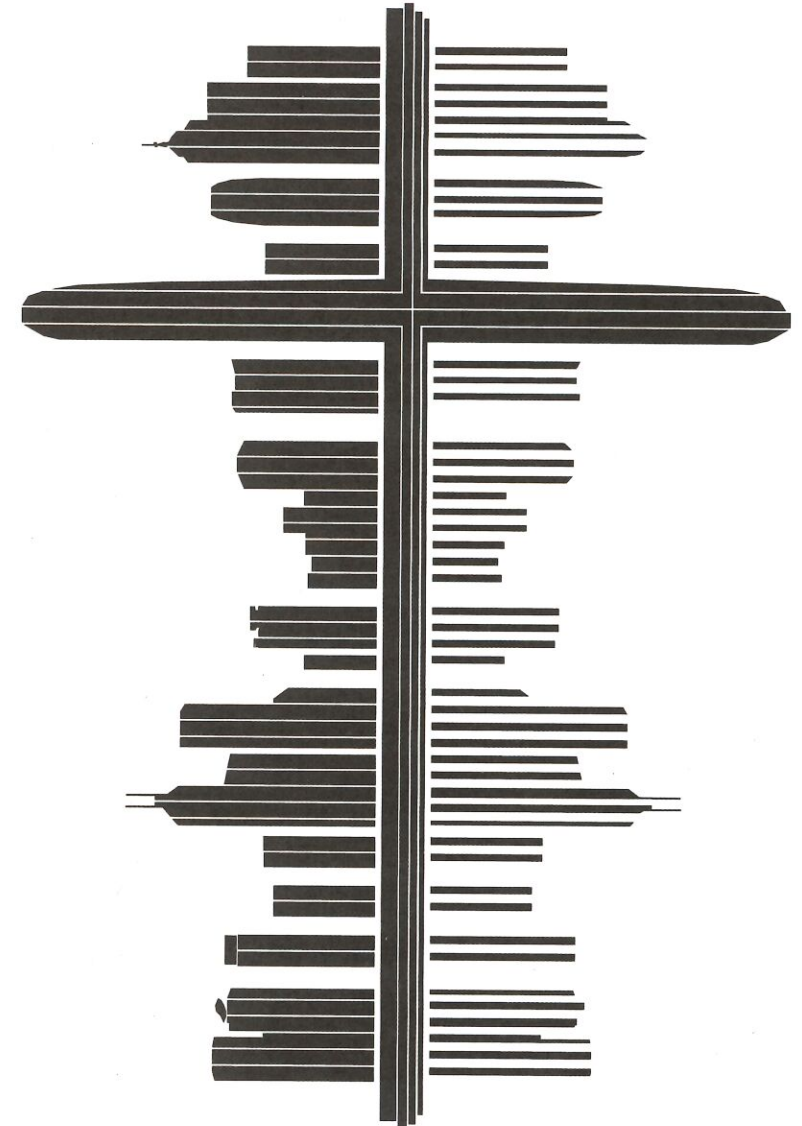
