When God Is All You Have

Judges 6:1-14

- 1. That God is <u>at work</u> is not the question- He is! Where and how He is at work are the questions.
- Understanding what God is about to do where you are is more important than you <u>telling God</u> what you want to do for Him.
- 3. Whenever God sets about to do something, He will always take the <u>initiative</u>.
- 4. We must ask to see things from God's <u>perspective</u> rather than from our human perspective.
- 5. When God speaks, it will always result in:
 - a. A crisis of belief
 - Badical adjustments I cannot stay where I am and go with God.
- 6. When God acts you will always know it is God.

Discussion Questions

- 1. That God is at work around you is not the question- He is! Where and how do you see Him at work around you? If you are not seeing God at work why do you think this is the case? Could there be something that is hindering you from hearing His voice? God longs to speak to our hearts but He does so in the midst of a relationship. As a group spend a few moments asking God what He is doing in and around your community group.
- 2. When we are facing difficult times we must ask God to show us His perspective and not rely on our human perspective. What are you walking through in your life that you would say with Gideon (6:13) "If the LORD is with us, why has all this happened to us?" Ask God to help you see things through God's eyes. Take time as a group to pray for one another as you walk through difficult situations. Also, spend a few moments thanking God that He will never abandon us (6:13) no matter how far we stray from Him.
- 3. When Gideon heard what God said to him he knew it was God speaking too him (6:22). Whenever you know that God has spoken to you it will always result in two things:
 - 1. A crisis of belief- do I really believe God has spoken to me?**
- 2. A radical adjustment in my life- I cannot stay where I am and go with God.

Is there something that the Lord has been showing you that He would have you to join Him? Are you moving in obedience to what you know God is calling you too?

** God will never call you to do something that will contradict what He has said in His word.
