Faith-filled living

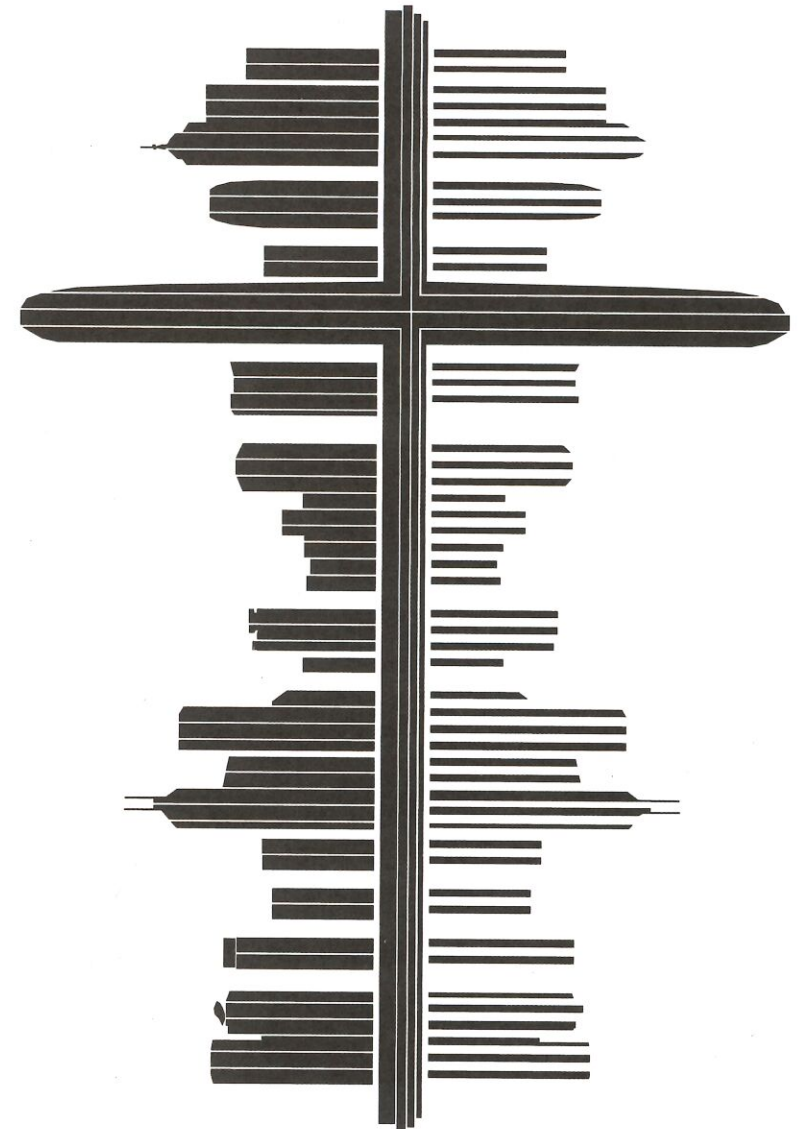
