Faith-filled living

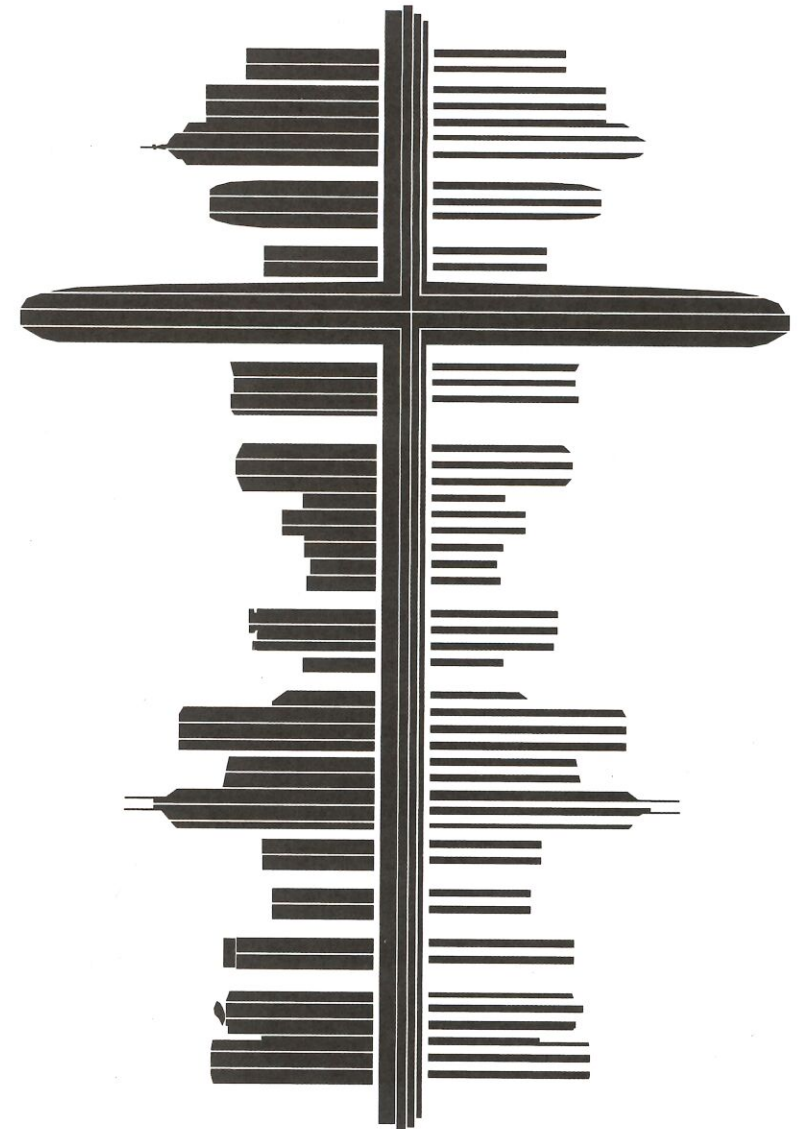

WORSHIP SERVICE RESUMES NEXT WEEK

Exciting news! AIC will restart our morning service in Alliance Primary School next Sunday, 21 June at 10:45 am. There are still guidelines and restrictions we must follow. Please read the additional information below that will help facilitate our time together.

1. Seating capacity is limited to 150 people. Therefore, the seating arrangement will be different from the past to maximize seating and maintain distancing. Please follow the instructions of greeters and ushers to help us efficiently use the space
2. Face masks, hand sanitization and temperature check are required. A record of your attendance and contact information is necessary.
3. We request that you do not attend if you feel unwell, have a body temperature above 37.5 C, recent cough, related symptoms or are part of our vulnerable population.
4. Arriving early will assist in completing check-in and seating in a timely manner.
5. Coffee and water will not be provided. Please bring your own water. Food cannot be consumed on the property.
6. We will continue to live stream the sermon from our Facebook page or visit <https://www.aic.org.hk/sermons/>. When full seating capacity is reached, we cannot admit more people. Please join us online.
7. Children must sit with their parent or responsible adult. There will not be classes or children's church. Please bring appropriate items for your children to use during the service.
8. You may give your offering online, in the donation box or as the offering is collected, using the offering bags during the service. When the offering is collected during the service, the ushers will retain hold of the collection bag. People are requested to not touch the handles.
9. There will not be printed bulletins. Please listen for announcements during the service or visit the AIC website to view a digital bulletin. Any pens supplied will be used once, then sanitized before re-using. Please bring a pen with you.
10. Filipino service will meet at 2pm on Sundays. Saturday Filipino service will begin on 26/06 and meet at 10:45am. Guidelines above must be applied to this setting. These 10 commandments are not inscribed in stone. As guidelines are revised from the various authorities, we will make adjustments to these instructions for future weeks.
