Faith-filled living

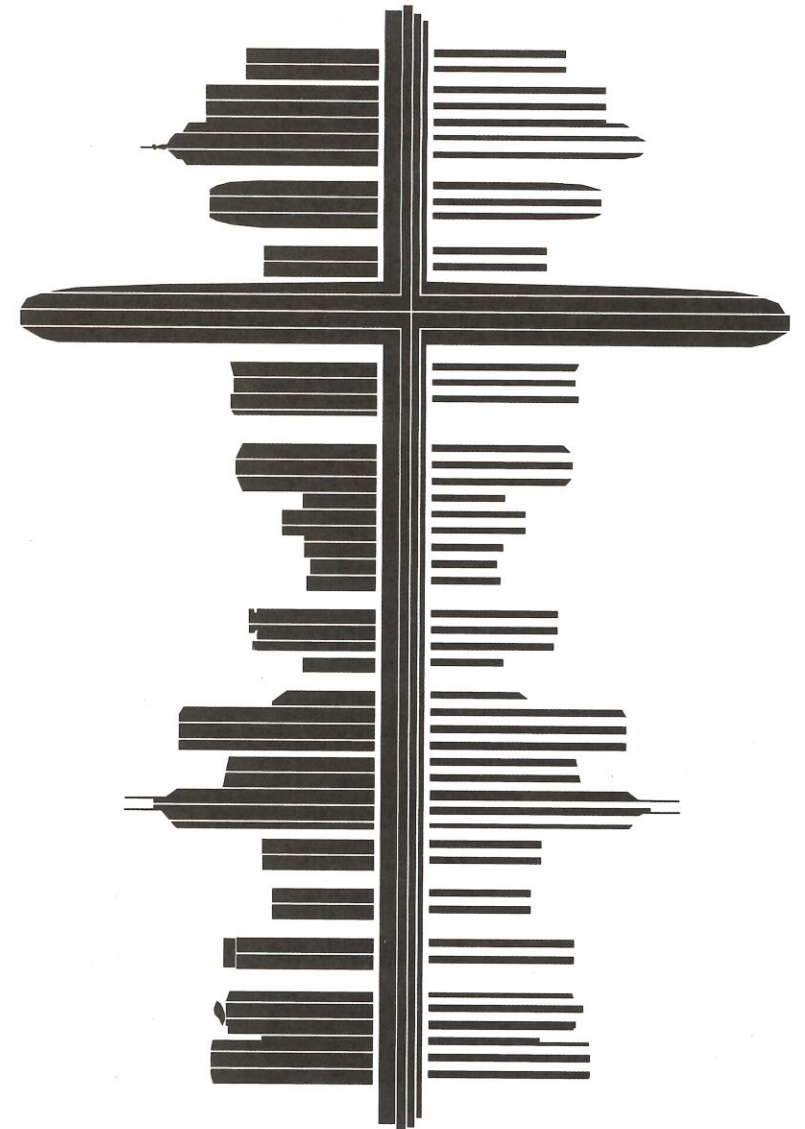

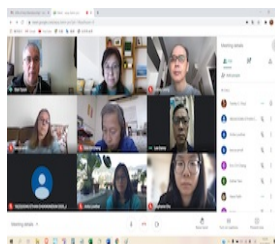
We are called to have fellowship – "Two are better than one"
