As a group read the text for this week Acts 13:1-12

1. The Holy Spirit is the One who gives spiritual gifts. No one gift is more important than the other. What is important is that we are using the gifts God has given to us. Go around the group and tell what gift God has given you. How can you use these gift/s to the glory of God especially during this time of pandemic?
 - a. If you don't know your spiritual gift please contact Pastor Joel and he will help you to discover your spiritual gift.
2. Fasting was a part of the early church. However, fasting is not practiced as much as it once was. Why is this? Why should we fast? (see. Matt 6:16) What are the benefits of fasting?
3. One of the marks of a disciple is that they are willing to be led by the Holy Spirit. (In your heart answer this question) Would you say that you are in the place spiritually where you are following the leading of the Spirit for your life? Why should we be led by the Spirit? (see John 16:13)
4. Wherever and whatever God asks of us He will empower us for the task that He has given us. Where or to what would you say you would need the empowerment of the Lord for?
5. Prayer Time:
 - a. Pray for one another especially concerning the needs that have come up in this community group meeting.
 - b. As a group talk about the possibility of fasting together for a particular need.
