**Zoom from 6:30 to 7:30 pm on Wednesday nights.**

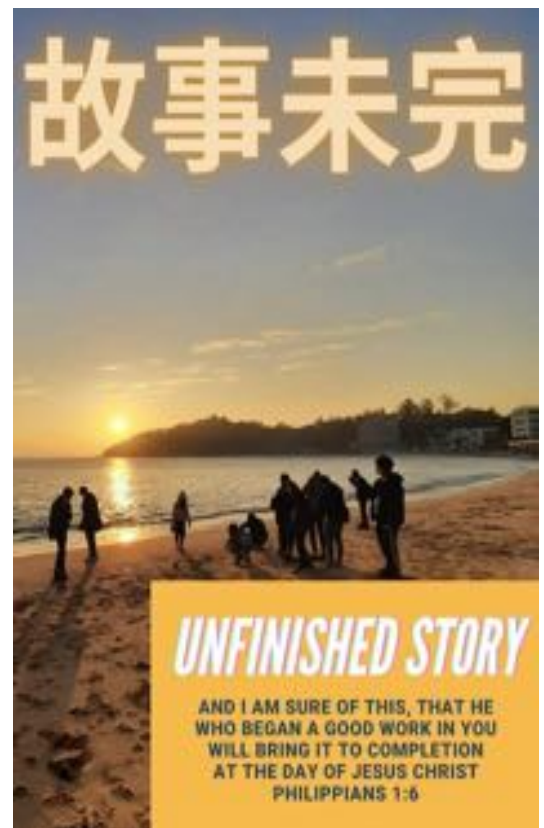
