## Sermon Discussion Questions

*Take a few moments as a group to read the scriptures Luke 18:18-23, 35-43, 19:1-10*

1. The rich young ruler came to Jesus with a question. What was that question? How do we receive eternal life? What did this man lack (see Mark 10:21)? Was this all that the man needed to do? Is salvation based upon works? Or did Jesus have something else in mind? Did this man follow Jesus? Or did He walk away? What can we learn from this man's encounter with Jesus.
2. In chapter 18 Jesus speaks about a persistent widow verses 1 and following and about a tax collector that cried out to God for mercy. How do we see each of these displayed in the blind man? When the man was healed what did he do? See verse 43. What lessons can we learn from this blind man?
3. Jesus comes to where Zacchaeus was and tells him that He must stay at his house that day. Why did the people grumble about this? Why do you think that Zacchaeus was interested in seeing Jesus? How did Zacchaeus' actions display that he had had a change of heart? What can we learn from Jesus' encounter with Zacchaeus?
