COVID-19 Update

With the continued easing of restrictions, we are pleased to announce that we can increase our meeting capacity to 85% and no longer be required to preregister for our Sunday service. To comply with government restrictions vaccine proof must be shown via the Leave Home Safe app, please note vaccine dosage requirements will increase on 31 May to **three doses** for more details visit the <u>government website</u>.

Every effort has been made to ensure safe gatherings, including the frequent sanitization of the church office and school classrooms. Please make sure you keep safe hygiene practices, including the use of masks, hand sanitizer, and temperature checking on arrival. There is to be no consumption of food on the premises.
