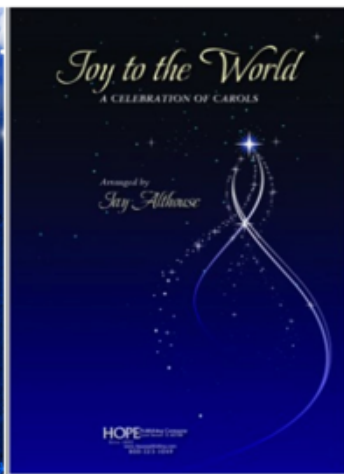

COVID-19 Update

With the continued easing of restrictions, we are pleased to announce that we can increase our meeting capacity to 85% and no longer be required to pre-register for our Sunday service. To comply with government restrictions vaccine proof must be shown via the Leave Home Safe app, please note vaccine dosage requirements increased on 31 May to **three doses**, for more details visit the [government website](#).
