

COVID-19 Update


With the continued easing of restrictions, we are pleased to announce that we can increase our meeting capacity to 85% and no longer be required to preregister for our Sunday service. To comply with government restrictions vaccine proof must be shown via the Leave Home Safe app, please note vaccine dosage requirements increased on 31 May to three doses, for more details visit the government website.

We kindly ask every person who enters Alliance Primary School, Whampoa to help us fulfill the following government regulations:

- All persons aged 12 and above, must scan "Leave Home Safe" before entering the school.
- Scan your vaccine pass at the check-in table before entering the worship hall or going to the classroom, or dropping kids at the Children's Church.
- No consumption of food or beverage on the premises.
