Pastor Henry also talked about two important truths that can help us move forward trusting in God's goodness:

- 1) Our past and our family no longer dictate our destiny. God holds our future in His hands.
- 2) Forgiveness does not necessarily equal reconciliation. We can forgive someone and still have a broken relationship. But the forgiveness is in obedience to God and unlocks the door towards peace and healing.

Consider to pray for each other, especially any issues or people you feel God is moving you to forgive.
