Read Isaiah 54:10 together.

- 2) Does anyone have a time in their life, including potentially right now, when you felt God's peace or your sensing of His presence in your life was lacking. What happened and did that change? (stop to listen and pray for anyone that is currently experiencing a lack of peace in their lives)
- 3) Share a time when life was difficult and yet God's peace did not depart from your heart. (Isaiah 54:10)
- 4) When have you felt most complete and whole in your life and faith?
