Rise Up! The Prayers of Elijah "Of Ravens and Widows" 1 Kings 17:1-24 April 21, 2024

Sermon Points:

- 1. Elijah declares a drought (1 Kings 17:1).
- 2. The Lord directs Elijah to leave and head for the Kerith Ravine (1 Kings 17:3-4).
- 3. The Lord then instructs Elijah to head to Sidon to meet a widow.
- 4. The widow felt she was out of options (1 Kings 17:12).
- 5. The Lord began to provide for Elijah, the widow, and her son (1 Kings 17:13-14, 1 Kings 17:15-16)
 - A. Doubt may still exist; be we can always say yes to the One who is Faithful.
- 6. The widow's son grew ill and stopped breathing (1 Kings 17:17-18)
- 7. Elijah pleaded to God to save the boy's life (1 Kings 17:19-21)
 - A. Prayer is not an incantation or magic spell, it is a conversation between you and God.
 - B. Our Prayers must be in accordance with His will and purpose.
- 8. The Lord heard Elijah's pleads and brought the boy back to life (1 Kings 17:22-24).
 - A. God is willing to perform a miracle for you just as he did for the widow.
 - B. Never lose grip of Jesus' sacrifice which he made for you.
