Sermon Points:

1. The Biblical Foundation for Work.

- Ephesians 6:5–9:
 - Addresses slaves/masters but applies to modern work relationships.
 - Key principle: Work "as unto the Lord" (v. 5, 7).

2. II. Two Perspectives on Work.

- For Employees (Eph 6:5–8).
 - Obey earthly leaders with sincerity, respect, and wholeheartedness (v. 5–6).
 - Work as if serving Christ, not people (v. 7).
 - God rewards faithfulness (v. 8).
- For Employers (Eph 6:9).
 - Lead with fairness, without threats or favoritism.
 - Remember: You answer to God (v. 9).

3. Gospel-Centered Work Diagnostics.

1. Identity:
 - Question: "How strongly is your identity based on your work or your title?"
2. Value:
 - Question: "Is your sense of worth (value) derived from your work or your title?"
3. Purpose:
 - Question: "What is your purpose?"

4. Is your walk at your work worthy of Jesus' reputation?
