 - o Understandably Afraid
 - o Notably Vulnerable
 - o Given Wealth and Honour

3. "Kindness" Word Study

- Not conditional on the receiver, BUT from the character of the giver
- Israel's khesed vs. LORD's khesed
 - o Hosea 6:4 short-lived
 - o Psalm 136 eternal
- 1 Samuel 20:12-17 David's "kindness" was to show the LORD's "kindness"

4. Humanity & Mephibosheth

- Enemies of God Romans 5:10
- Spiritually disabled Ephesians 2:1-3
- Reconciliation Colossians 1:21-22
- Heirs with Christ Romans 8:17
- Takeaway: God's Faithfulness Seeks and Supplies
 - o Culminates and fulfilled in the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ
 - o Question is, how will we respond?
