Questions (For personal reflection and small group discussion)

1. Where have you experienced the wine running out in your life? (In your joy, your strength, your relationships, your sense of worth)
2. The sermon talked about a few ways we try to fill our emptiness. Which of these patterns shows up most in you?
3. The servants obeyed even when Jesus' command made absolutely no sense. Where might Jesus be asking you to trust and obey right now, even when you can't see how it will turn out?
4. Have you ever had a moment when your simple, faithful obedience became the channel for something unexpectedly beautiful?
5. Read John 2:1-12 together. What details stand out to you in this story that you might not have noticed before?
6. The world offers cheap wine that always runs out. Jesus offers the finest wine, himself. How can we help each other remember this when we're tempted to fill our emptiness with cheaper things?
7. What would it look like for you this week to bring your emptiness to Jesus and say, "Do whatever you tell me"?
