- **Introductory Question:** *“What was a time you accidentally hurt yourself?”*
 - Thorns are a symbol and image of the curse of sin and the Fall
 - Jesus took thorns upon himself with purpose and intention, not accidentally
 - **Takeaway: Jesus Has The Real Power**

 - Daniel 7:13-14 - “worshiped”
 - Matthew 30x, Mark 14x, Luke 25x, John 12x
 - John 3:13-15 - “must be lifted up”
 - V.8-9 - Afraid (Matthew 27:19)
 - V.10 - Threat of Power
 - V.11 - Source of Power is Above
 - Greater Sin? Judas, Caiaphas, Satan
 - Consent of the Father, Pleasure of the Son, Presence of the Spirit
 - V.12 - Political Shift
 - V.13-14 - Ironic Proclamation
 - V.15 - Rejection of the Messiah
